**Musical Theatre West** is one of Southern California's oldest musical theatre companies. Now in its 56th year, the company has garnered national recognition and critical acclaim. Eight years ago, Musical Theatre West became a resident company at the Carpenter Performing Arts Center, presenting four major productions each year along with a Summer Youth Conservatory, a Holiday Show, and numerous special events. Each show is produced locally giving aspiring talent the opportunity to perform alongside seasoned professionals.

Musical Theatre West productions play to capacity crowds and rave reviews. In the last several years the company has won L.A. Stage Alliance Ovation Awards for Best Musical Ensemble, Best Supporting Actress, Best Actor in a Musical, and Best Choreographer.

An important outreach to the community is the Youth Cultural Enrichment Program which introduces over 17,000 students annually to the joy and magic of musical theatre. Special performances of our shows are given for the schools, and cast members also visit the classrooms providing an insight into the world of theatre. The laughter and applause from these youngsters indicate it is an art form they will enjoy for many years to come.

**Musical Theatre West** is dedicated to preserving musical theatre as a unique American art form and enriching the cultural life of Southern California through the presentation of established musicals, the development of new works, and the expansion of our Youth Cultural Enrichment Program.

**Musical Theatre West Footlighters** was formed ten years ago to support and promote Musical Theatre West through the sponsorship of special events and other activities that ensure the success of the organization and its goals. Music In The Morning luncheons are held before each show, along with Opening Night dinners.
